#Train4Tomorrow offers free, high quality, digital and technical training to employed and unemployed adults. The training is designed by industry to meet their open and live vacancies. Skills Bootcamps are flexible courses, up to 16 weeks; giving people the opportunity to build up specific-sector skills and fast-track to an interview with a local employer or aid promotion within.

The programme, funded through the National Skills Fund, includes different digital and technical Skills Bootcamps that have been designed to help local people advance or pivot their skills into growing sectors resilient to the current economic downturn.

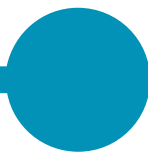

Activities to support Net Zero Retro Fit

Within the Skills Bootcamp, learners will gain knowledge and practical skills in a variety of tasks such as:

- Safely change a normal halogen light bulb to an energy efficient LED
- Replacing a toilet cistern from 9 litre to dual flush 6/1.5 litre
- Adding trickle vents to UPVC double glazed windows
- Installing loft insulation to meet current building regulations
- Installing ventilation unit into cloakrooms and bathrooms
- Installing thermostatic radiator valves
- Water conservation through basic plumbing Skills
- Gutter repairs and water harvesting
- Building fabric property maintenance solutions

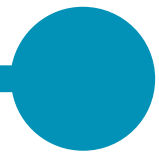




Next Steps
